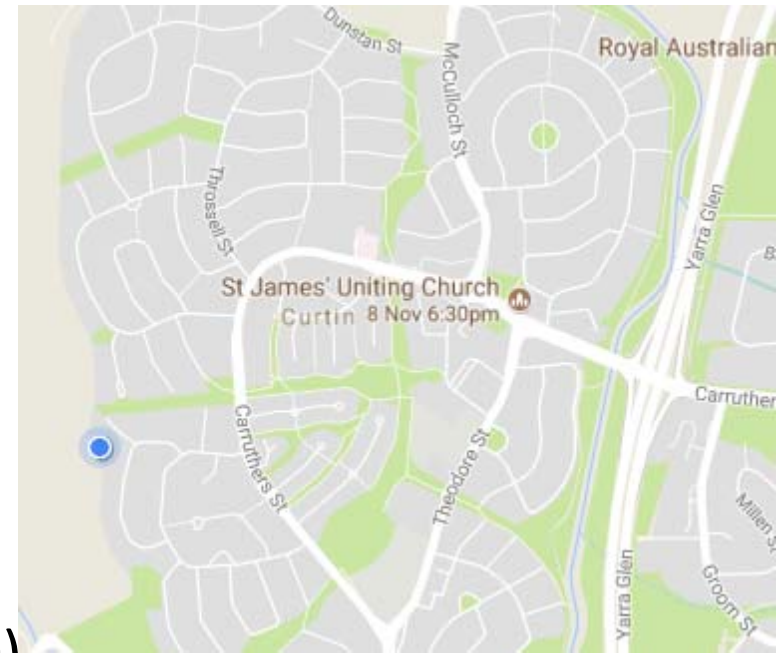

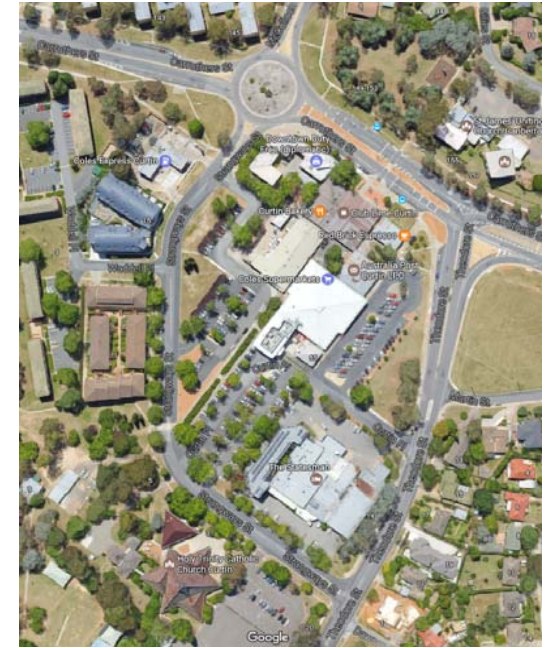

Curtin: Character

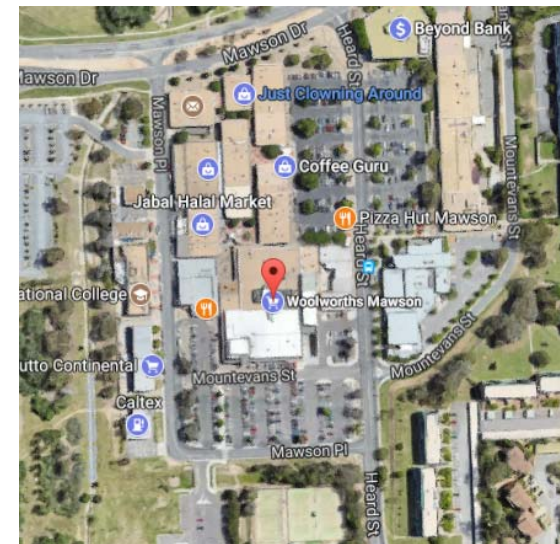
- Early suburb : largest of 12 in WV
- 5,200 of WV 35,300 residents
- 2,000 of WV 15,000 dwellings
- Group Centre (with adjacent suburbs – 15,000)
- Substantial Radburn development
- Strong community focus
- Home for special accommodaton/services



Curtin: Woden Valley Context



- Master Plan for Curtin Group Centre
- Complementary to developing WTC
- Spatially links WV with Deakin, Yarralumla



Curtin: Meeting Challenges (CRA priorities)

- CRA – framework for supporting action groups and enthusiasms
- Master Plan for the Curtin Group Centre
 - Draft completed November 2015
 - Public comment closed February 2016 – vision, strategies, recommendations supported
 - Still not finalised – Community Panel process introduced July 2017
- Ensuring public domain standing in densification developments
 - Commercial and Residential zones
 - Horse paddocks and Yarralumla Creek corridor
- Traffic flow between WV, Weston/Molonglo
- Vision for WV
