## 1 Special address

Jeremy Hanson MLA

What will the Canberra Liberals do for Woden Valley?

Jeremy covered a range of issues, both Canberra-wide and local. There were questions about funding of campaign promises, and the problems of declining services and rising rates.

## 2 Community Consultation - Presentations on pre-Development Applications

(a) Doma group development section 2 block 180 (corner of Furzer and Corinna Streets; many will know the site as the former carpark south of Aviation House)

Marcus Graham from Stewart Architects presented Doma's plans for the site, which will include 2 buildings of 10 and 12 storeys respectively, and two of 16 storeys.. There were questions about solar access to the pocket park to the south of the site, and building set-backs. Doma's preference for 'straight' building facades was noted

## 3 President and committee reports

Including Woden Community Centre (a home for Woden Community Service planned for north-eastern corner of Woden Town Park); community space in Woden Library (improved public access is planned to meeting rooms on ground floor, and new spaces on first floor); Chris Erett presented his report on a Pre-DA consultation on social housing on former Strathgordon site. Traffic flow in and around the site was an issue. Jenny noted that committee member Rollo Brett had attended a consultation on the Lord Phillip site in Botany Street. There was insufficient time to present Rollo's report.
